

Bone Cancer Research Trust in-person events Code of Conduct

- 1. To respect each other's right to privacy, please keep information you see or hear to yourself and refrain from sharing with others without permission.
- 2. Do not take photographs or videos without seeking consent in advance from other attendees or Bone Cancer Research Trust (BCRT) staff.
- 3. In-person events provide peer-to-peer support for the primary bone cancer community. Be mindful that any medical information shared is based on an individual's diagnosis and may not be applicable to your personal circumstances.
- 4. Use respectful and appropriate language. Do not use terms or swear words or use abusive or threatening language that attendees may find offensive.
- 5. Being under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs is prohibited; if suspected you will be asked to leave the event.
- 6. Inappropriate behaviour towards attendees or BCRT staff will not be tolerated. If such incident occurs, you will be escorted from the venue and will not be able to return.
- 7. Children always remain the responsibility of parents/ guardians during the event.
- 8. Personal/valuable items brought to the event are at the attendees' own risk and BCRT assumes no responsibility if these items are stolen/damaged.
- 9. All attendees must be registered prior to the event to ensure BCRT staff can manage capacity.
- 10. BCRT staff **must** be informed of any dietary requirements prior to the event.
- 11. Please ensure name badges (if provided) are worn and can been seen clearly.
