You'll team up with our staff at designated cheer points along the marathon route:

- Cheer Point 1 – Shadwell (mile 13 & 21): the cheer point will be located in front of St George's Leisure centre on the same side of the road. It is a 5 minute walk from Shadwell Station.
- Cheer Point 2 – Westminster (mile 25): the cheer point will be located in front of Big Ben on the same side of the road. It is easily accessible via Exit 3 from Westminster Underground Station.

You should be able to spot our cheer point, branded with our bright orange flags and banners!
