## **Event Timings**

1pm - 7pm. We anticipate our fastest runners to arrive at the venue from 1:30pm, which should give you time to set up ahead their arrival. We expect our busiest period to be from 3pm onwards but this is dependent on finishing times and conditions on the day.

## **Location**

## **Breaks**

You will receive a break of minimum 20 minutes. We ask that breaks be staggered between yourself and the other physiotherapists to ensure at least 2-3 of you are available for treating runners at any one time.

## **Parking / Transport**

There will be road closures on the day meaning it will be difficult to park a vehicle close to the venue to unload. However, we can arrange parking in the [NCP London Soho Brewer Street](#) car park (16 minute walk) or [NCP London Brunswick Square](#) car park (28 minute walk). If you are struggling with equipment on the day, one of our team can meet you to give you a hand.

## **Expenses**

The Bone Cancer Research Trust will cover reasonable travel expenses within Greater London and lunch will be provided. Volunteers should retain any travel and parking receipts to be submitted alongside an expenses claim form following the event.

## **Equipment**

It is your responsibility to ensure that your insurance and certificate to work are up to date. We ask you to bring with you the necessary equipment you need to fulfil the role, such as a treatment couch, couch roll, wipes, alcohol gel, towels and oils. Ice will be provided by the venue.



## **Responsibility**

Volunteers will be representing the Bone Cancer Research Trust on the day of the event and we ask that you conduct yourselves in a professional manner at all times.
